NFPA 484 2022 Edition Chapter 13 States



Disposal of Sludge from Water-Based Wet-Type Air-Material Separators.

- All sludge removed from wet-type AMS shall be removed daily at a minimum.
- Sludge should be disposed of in accordance with applicable federal, state and local requirements.
- Material removed shall be permitted to be mixed with an inert material (e.g. sand or material that is non-reactive with combustible metal) in a volume ratio of at least five parts inert to one part metal dust.
- Sludge level in sludge tank shall not exceed 5 percent of the tank liquid capacity as measured by volume.
- The maximum capacity shall not exceed 20 lb (9kg) of sludge.
